

# Project "Education on global citizenship and health"

#### Context:

- Health is a fundamental and universally recognized human right and it is part of the international legislation. It is essential to achieve human beings' full potential and for the physical, intellectual and emotional growth of each individual. It is also essential for the development of the productive and learning abilities needed to guarantee personal economical well-being and social progress both essential to avoid the raising of inequities and consequential social conflicts.
- Differences and inequities in health both within societies and between States are significant indicators of the lack of fulfillment of this right, conflicting with today available knowledge and resources, politically and ethically unacceptable.
- Education has proved to be one of the most effective investments to promote equity, justice, development and peace.
- There is a strong common commitment of all nations to fight against poverty and to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals

### General objectives

• To foster the idea of a global shared citizenship and the concept of global health, by raising awareness on global interdependence and stimulating the sense of belonging to a universal community, in order to reach SDG number 4.7 (learning to live together sustainably)

### Specific objective

• To achieve and promote **educational paths related to global health**, by involving local organizations in Italy (Universities, educational authorities, civil society organizations and immigrant communities' associations).
